Rebeca Rocamora Nadal was born in Granja de Rocamora (Alicante, Spain) on 7th September 1975. Blonde, with big blue eyes and calmed glance, her innocence, vitality and joy stood out since her childhood. She soon knew about the illness that would accompany her for her whole life without ever losing her beautiful smile.

Within the bosom of her family, she took her first steps in the Catholic faith, wich she developed with simplicity and commitment in her parish mainly dedicating all her strengh on her children catechism. Rebeca grew as a girl whose both ordinary life: school, family, friends... and the most important thing for her: God, the Cross, preaching were naturally combined emphasizing her love to others and forgetting herself.

Thus, considering the appearance of a new and unforeseeable disease, her soul quickly grew up, cheering people up and accepting the proof embraced by God's will.

When she was at death's door, her words to those who insisted on her asking for health were: "Lord knows that if it advisible, he will give it to me. I beg him to strengthen my faith". Those words showed a heart with a great and deep faith.

She died on Sunday 26th May 1996, Solemnity of Pentecost, at the age of 20, leaving a life testimony full of youth and beauty given to God. Her cause of canonization was opened on 14th March 2009. Her young life devoted to God should be seen as a guide to encourage other young people.
